

Utah Research Project

Utah is a fascinating and beautiful place. You will be researching the regions of Utah and a state park discovering the things that make Utah unique.

Requirements:

- Create a NoodleTools Project and share it with Miss Nelson and your teacher
- Create note cards in NoodleTools that fully cover the topics
- Create an outline
- Create a bibliography
- Write a report using main ideas and supporting details
- Create a project- Map of Utah (see below)

Report Requirements:

- A. Introduction (list the three regions of Utah)
- B. Where is Utah located? (latitude, longitude, hemisphere, continent, etc.) Describe the three regions of Utah.
- C. State Park- What is the history of the park? What can you do for fun at the state park? What are some other interesting facts about the state park?
- D. What region of Utah is the state park located in? What inferences can you make as to why the park is located in that area? What inferences can you make about how Utah's environment has changed over time?
- E. Conclusion

Project Requirements:

- Create a map of Utah showing and labeling the three regions of Utah
- Identify and label: The Great Salt Lake, Utah Lake, Bear Lake, Sevier Lake, Lake Powell
- Label the state park you researched
- Identify and label these cities: Salt Lake City, Provo, Logan, Ogden, Nephi, Fillmore, Cedar City, St. George, Moab, Vernal
- Add a title to the map and a key identifying symbols and listing cities from the most populated city to the least populated city.
